The appropriation has been developed on the assumption that the department will produce 1.8 million maps, which is the same number produced during the last printing in the early 1980's. This bill includes appropriate funding for 2 positions, an Illustrator II and a Clerk Typist I, to perform additional work as a result of highway map production. In addition, the bill includes costs for a printer for press proofs, preparation, plates, printing, stock and freight and map distribution costs. |
