18 Transportation to Produce the State

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
22 follows:

23 **Sec 1. Map authorized.** The Department of Trans-  
24 portation shall produce highway maps of the State.

25 **Sec 2. Appropriation.** The following funds are  
26 appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the  
27 purposes of this Act.

10 STATEMENT OF FACT

11 This bill provides for the production of a high-  
12 way map of the State by the Department of Transporta-  
13 tion. The appropriation has been developed on the  
14 assumption that the department will produce 1.8 mil-  
15 lion maps, which is the same number produced during  
16 the last printing in the early 1980's. This bill in-  
17 cludes appropriate funding for 2 positions, an  
18 Illustrator II and a Clerk Typist I, to perform addi-  
19 tional work as a result of highway map production.  
20 In addition, the bill includes costs for a printer  
21 for press proofs, preparation, plates, printing,  
22 stock and freight and map distribution costs.
