20	STATEMENT OF FACT
21 22 23	The purpose of this bill is to maintain the integrity of undercover law enforcement operatives by prohibiting their payment with nonpublic funds.
24 25 26 27 28	The integrity and unpartiality of such operatives is also enhanced by prohibiting the communication to 3rd parties of information of a noncriminal nature received during the course of a criminal investigation.
