- 'Sec. 7. Effective date. The provisions of this
 Act shall become effective on January 1, 1988, provided that Maine's application to join the International Registration Plan is approved.
- q Sec. 8. Report. The Office of Policy and Legal Analysis and the Office of Fiscal and Program Review 10 shall conduct a study to determine the comparative 11 costs of truck operations between Maine and the other 12 13 New England states and the Provinces of New Brunswick 14 and Quebec. A report shall be published to be submit-15 ted at the First Regular Session of the 113th Legislature. 16
- 17 Further amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency clause.

19 STATEMENT OF FACT

- This amendment amends various sections of the bill to make necessary adjustments for the effective implementation of the International Registration Plan.
- 1. Section 4 is amended to change the entry date from September 1, 1987, to January 1, 1989.
- 26 2. The bill is amended to allow the proration of excise tax when vehicle registrations under the International Registration Plan are shifted from the staggered registration system to the annual January 1st to December 31st registration year.
- 31 3. A new section 7 of the bill establishes an

- 1 effective date of January 1, 1988.
- The Division of Motor Vehicles intends to make application for entrance into the International Registration Plan in the summer of 1986. The approval process will take several months. If Maine's application is approved, the Division of Motor Vehicles will 5 6 7 request the necessary funding for a January 1, 1989, entry date.
