18 AN ACT to Prevent Discrimination Against
19 Retired Maine Residents who have
20 Previously been Members of the Maine
21 State Retirement System.

23 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
24 follows:

25 5 MRSA §285, sub-§1, ¶G, as amended by PL 1985,
26 c. 391, §§1 and 7, is further amended to read:

27 G. Subject to subsection 1-A, employees in any
28 of the categories denominated in paragraphs A to
29 F who:

30 (1) On April 26, 1968, have retired and who
31 were covered under plans of insurance which
32 by virtue of Public Law 1967, chapter 543
33 were terminated;

1 (2) After April 26, 1968, retire and who on
2 the date of their retirement are currently
3 enrolled in this group accident and sickness
4 or health insurance plan; ~~or~~

5 (3) After December 2, 1986, and after
6 reaching normal retirement age, cease to be
7 members of the Legislature and are recipi-
8 ents of retirement allowances from the Maine
9 State Retirement System based upon credit-
10 able service as teachers, as defined by sec-
11 tion 1001, subsection 25. This paragraph
12 shall also apply to former members who were
13 members on December 2, 1986; or

14 (4) After December 2, 1986, and not yet
15 normal retirement age, cease to be members
16 of the Legislature and are recipients of re-
17 retirement allowances from the Maine State Re-
18 retirement System based upon creditable ser-
19 vice as teachers, as defined by section
20 1001, subsection 25. This paragraph also
21 applies to former members who were members
22 on December 2, 1986.

23 STATEMENT OF FACT

24 This bill extends eligibility for group accident
25 and sickness or health insurance to former members of
26 the Legislature receiving retirement benefits from
27 the Maine State Retirement System based on creditable
28 service as teachers.
