In <u>Except as otherwise provided in this subsection</u>, in the case of a child conceived and born out of wedlock, the name of the putative father shall not be entered on the certifi-16 17 18 19 cate without his written consent. The signature of 20 21 the putative father on the written consent shall be 22 acknowledged before an official authorized to take oaths. Hewever, if Within a reasonable time after the 23 24 acknowledgement, the official taking the acknowledge-25 ment shall make a good faith effort to notify the 26 mother of the child for whom paternity has been acknowledged. Notification shall be by certified mail, 27 28 return receipt requested, or by in hand notice. If a 29 determination of paternity has been made by a 30 of competent jurisdiction, then the name of the fa-31 ther as determined by the court shall be entered on the birth certificate without the father's consent.'
