B, §9, is amended to read: 13 Taxable year. "Taxable year" for purposes of 14 15 section 1504, subsection 5, means from January 1st to 16 December 31st for watercraft subject to the excise 17 tax but not required to be registered under Title 12, 18 section 7794. For watercraft required to be registered under Title 12, section 7794, "taxable year" 19 20 means the 12-month period of registration. 21 Sec.4. 36 MRSA §1504, sub-§3, ¶C, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 92, Pt. B, §9, is amended to read: 22 23 C. The commissioner State Tax Assessor shall determine a vessel's established base of operation 24 25 if 2 or more municipalities disagree over which 26 taxing jurisdiction has the right to tax a par-27 ticular vessel. The commissioner's State Tax 28 Assessor's decision shall be final. Further amend the bill in section 7, in subsection 7, in the first line (page 3, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined word "documented" and in 29 30 31 the 3rd line (page 3, line 9 in L.D.) by inserting after the word "chapter" the following: 'but not re-32 33 quired to be registered under Title 12, section 7794' 34 35 Further amend the bill by renumbering the sec-36 tions to read consecutively.

1 2	Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:
3	'FISCAL NOTE
4 5 6 7 8 9	It is estimated that enactment of this bill results in income to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife of \$1,000 from the sale to municipalities and Indian reservations of excise tax decals. The department will also experience a savings of \$23,000 as a result of not being required to supply tax decals for registered watercraft.'
11	STATEMENT OF FACT
12 13 14 15 16 17 18	This amendment deletes the provision of the original bill which treated residents and nonresidents differently for purposes of the excise tax. It also requires all watercraft not required to be registered to display an excise tax decal. The original bill had included only documented watercraft in this requirement.
