22 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
23 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
24 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

25 Whereas, the salary increases established in this
26 legislation should take effect immediately; and

27 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
28 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
29 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
30 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
31 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
32 therefore,

33 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
34 follows:

13 223, is amended to read:

14 §1401. Purpose

15 The purpose of this chapter is to establish in
16 Waldo County a method of appropriating money for
17 county expenditures, according to a budget, which
18 shall first receive approval of a budget committee.
19 This chapter amends the present statutory method in
20 sections 2, 252 and 253 by transferring the authority
21 of the Waldo County legislative delegation and the
22 Legislature to approve the Waldo County budget to a
23 committee comprised of Waldo County and municipal of-
24 ficials. This chapter shall apply only to Waldo
25 County.

26 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited
27 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-
28 proved.
