STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill places in the unclassified service utility accountant III positions at the Public Utilities Commission. Like the commission's staff attorneys, financial analysts and chief utility accountant, which are now in the unclassified service, the utility accountant III positions are high level, policy-making positions that are unique in State Government. The commission has had difficulty in recruiting and retaining an adequate number of qualified Placing these positions people for these positions. in the unclassified service gives the commission an effective tool to recruit and retain qualified personnel, reduce consultant costs and assure the public interest is fairly represented in proceedings before the commission.

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
