19 Organizations from the Sales Tax.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§55 is enacted to
24 read:

25 55. Incorporated nonprofit hospice organiza-
26 tions. Sales to incorporated nonprofit hospice orga-
27 nizations which provide a program of care for the
28 physical and emotional needs of terminally ill pa-
29 tients.

30 Sec. 2. Allocation. The following funds are al-
31 located from the Local Government Fund to carry out
32 the purposes of this Act.
