'Amend the Resolve by striking out everything after the emergency preamble and before the emergency clause and inserting in its place the following:

Commission established. Resolved: shall be established a commission to commemorate the bicentennial of the United States Constitution. commission shall consist of 7 members appointed as follows: Two by the Governor; 2 by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court; one by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; one by the President of the Senate; and a chairman appointed jointly by the Governor, Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court, Speaker of the House of Representatives President of the Senate. The members shall serve without compensation, but may be reimbursed for reasonable expenses as provided in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 12002-A, subsection 1. The commission shall advice the Office of the Bicentennial of the Constitution and the project director as set out in this resolve; and be it further

Office of the Bicentennial of the Constitution.
Resolved: That there shall be an Office of the Bicentennial of the Constitution, referred to in this resolve as "the office," within the Administrative Office of the Courts. The office shall continue in existence through December 31, 1987. This office
