Reversion to State. Resolved: That title and ownership of the property conveyed to the inhabitants of the Town of Jackman, as provided in this resolve, shall be retained, operated, maintained and used for public outdoor recreational purposes, and shall revert to the State in the event that these conditions are not met.

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26 27 The conveyance shall be on such terms and conditions and for such consideration as the director may direct.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

The property proposed to be conveyed was acquired for public boat access purposes. During the period since acquisition determination has been made that the subject parcel, because of its topographic conditions, is not suitable to development of a public access facility, and an agreement was executed with the Town of Jackman to provide for public outdoor recreational use of the property. The town and the Bureau of Parks and Recreation favor the provision of public boat access at an alternate, nearby town-owned loca-The subject property would be transferred to the town following development of a public boat access site at the alternate town-owned property. visions for continuing and nondiscriminating outdoor recreation uses or reversion to the State would be contained in the deed of conveyance.

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
