20 21	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
22 23	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7076, sub-§4, as amended by PL 1983, c. 797, §4, is further amended to read:
24 25 26 27 28	4. Resident disabled war veterans. A complimentary license to hunt or fish, or a combination hunting and fishing license and, if requested, a pheasant hunting permit, shall be issued to any resident of Maine who:
29 30	A. Is a veteran, as defined in Title 37-A, section 28;
31 32 33	B. Has a service connected disability evaluated at 70% or more as a result of honorable military service;

1 2 3	C. Has served in a combat zone during either World War I, World War II, the Korean War or the Viet Nam War; and
4	D. Applies for that license to the commissioner.
5 6 7 8 9 10	This application shall be accompanied by a photo copy of the applicant's final DD form 214 or other evidence satisfactory to the commissioner that the applicant meets the requirements of this subsection. Each license issued under this subsection shall remain valid through December 31st of the 2nd complete calendar year following the year of issuance.
