18 AN ACT to Repeal the Pheasant Stamp.
19

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7076, sub-§4, as amended by PL
23 1983, c. 797, §4, is further amended to read:

24 4. Resident disabled war veterans. A complimen-
25 tary license to hunt or fish, or a combination hunt-
26 ing and fishing license and, if requested, a pheasant
27 hunting permit, shall be issued to any resident of
28 Maine who:

29 A. Is a veteran, as defined in Title 37-A, sec-
30 tion 28;

31 B. Has a service connected disability evaluated
32 at 70% or more as a result of honorable military
33 service;

1 C. Has served in a combat zone during either
2 World War I, World War II, the Korean War or the
3 Viet Nam War; and

4 D. Applies for that license to the commissioner.

5 This application shall be accompanied by a photo copy
6 of the applicant's final DD form 214 or other evi-
7 dence satisfactory to the commissioner that the ap-
8 plicant meets the requirements of this subsection.
9 Each license issued under this subsection shall re-
10 main valid through December 31st of the 2nd complete
11 calendar year following the year of issuance.

12 Sec. 2. 12 M RSA §7106, as amended by PL 1979, c.
13 543, §11, is repealed.

14 STATEMENT OF FACT

15 This bill repeals the pheasant stamp law.
