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SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 830, L.D. 2090,
Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Amount of Insurance for
Vehicles Used in Transporting Students."

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Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting
clause the following:

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'Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §831, as amended by PL 1973, c.
469, §8, is further amended to read:

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§831. Insurance for vehicles for hire

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The Secretary of State shall not register any mo-
tor vehicle rented or leased on plans commonly known
as U-Drive, Drive Yourself or Driverless Car plans
nor any motor vehicle used for livery or hire, except
as provided in Title 35, section 1510, ~~ex~~ as a ~~sehel~~
~~bus~~, and no person, firm or corporation shall may op-
erate or cause to be operated upon any public highway
in this State any such motor vehicle, until the owner
or owners thereof shall have procured insurance or a
bond, having a surety company authorized to transact
business in this State or 2 individuals as sureties
thereon, in the amount of \$20,000 because of bodily
injury or death to any one person, and subject to
~~said~~ the limit respecting one person, in the amount
of \$40,000 because of bodily injury to or death to 2
or more persons in any one accident, and in the
amount of \$10,000 because of injury to and destruc-
tion of property in any one accident, which insurance
or bond shall be approved by the Secretary of State
and shall indemnify the insured against any legal li-
ability for personal injury, the death of any person
or property damage, which injury, death or damage may
result from or have been caused by the operation of
the motor vehicle described in the contract of insur-
ance or such bond. The Secretary of State shall not


1 approve the policy or bond unless it provides primary
2 coverage for the operator as well as the owner.'

3 Further amend the bill by inserting at the begin-
4 ning of the first line after the enacting clause the
5 following: 'Sec. 2.'

6 STATEMENT OF FACT

7 The purpose of this amendment is to remove refer-
8 ence to school buses in the Maine Revised Statutes,
9 Title 29, section 831, since the bill establishes a
10 new section dealing with higher amounts of insurance
11 for vehicles used in transporting students.
