STATE OF MAINE
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SIX
AN ACT to Establish the Maine State Parks Development Fund.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
<pre>Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §602, sub-§18 is enacted to read:</pre>
18. Maine State Parks Development Fund. To ad-
minister the Maine State Parks Development Fund es- tablished under section 609.
Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §609 is enacted to read:
§609. Maine State Parks Development Fund
The Maine State Parks Development Fund is estab-
lished within the bureau for the purpose of develop- ing new state parks on state-owned land.

1	Income from legislative appropriation, gifts,
2	grants and bequests may be deposited in this fund.
3	The fund shall be nonlapsing.
4	All funds of the Maine State Parks Development
5	Fund shall be subject to allocation by the Legisla-
6	ture.
7	STATEMENT OF FACT
8	The Maine State Parks Development Fund will per-
9	mit the State to set aside money for the purpose of
10	developing state parks. The fiscal year 1987 appro-
11	priation to this fund is \$100,000. Future Legisla-
12	tures may make additional incremental appropriations
13	and, when sufficient funds were realized, the devel-
14	opment of a new state park may be completed.
15	The cost of this appropriation would be offset by
16	a restructuring of fees for state parks resulting in
17	increased revenues.
18	Funds for this bill are included in the Gover-
19	nor's budget.

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
