25	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves
26 27	of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies;

29	Whereas, Resolves 1985, chapter 47, required the
30 31	Joint Select Committee on Nursing Care Needs to sub- mit its report to the Legislature; and
32	Whereas, in order to give the committee time to
33 34	adequately prepare its report, an extension until January 31, 1986, is necessary; and

1 Whereas, Resolves 1985, chapter 36, required the 2 special commission to study the Utilization of Vacant 3 Buildings at Pineland Center and submit its report to 4 the Legislature by January 10, 1986; and

5 Whereas, that deadline provided insufficient time 6 to properly prepare such a report; and

7 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 8 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 9 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 10 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-11 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 12 therefore, be it

13 Sec. 1. Joint Select Committee on Nursing Care 14 Needs. Resolved: That, notwithstanding Resolves 15 1985, chapter 47, the Joint Select Committee on Nurs-16 ing Care Needs shall submit its report to the Legis-17 lature no later than March, 1986; and be it further
