18 AN ACT Relating to the Age of Employees who  
19 may Receive Payment or be in the  
20 Direct Handling of Liquor on the  
21 Licensed Premises.

23 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
24 follows:

25 Sec. 1. 28 MRSA §751-A, as amended by PL 1985,  
26 c. 402, §4, is repealed and the following enacted in  
27 its place:

28 §751-A. Payment for sales in retail stores

29 For the purpose of receiving payment at the  
30 check-out counters for the sale of malt liquor or ta-  
31 ble wine in retail stores, the age of the employee  
32 receiving the payment shall not be under 17 years of  
33 age. An employee who is 17 years of age may received  
34 payment only if an employee who is 18 years of age or  
35 older is present in the retail store in a supervisory  
36 capacity.
