7 P&SL 1985, c. 18, Pt. A, Sec. 16 is amended to 8 read:

Sec. 16. Unified state budget. The Governor, when submitting the budget to the Legislature, shall submit the budget document and the General Fund, Highway Fund, including all funds pertaining to Department of Public Safety and the Department of Transportation, and funds of Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife bills in a manner that will identify the gross amount of resources for each pro-The gross unified budget bills and budget document shall encompass resources from all funds, including, but not limited to: General Fund, Highway Fund, Federal Fund, Federal Block Grant Fund and othspecial revenue funds. Separate gross unified budget bills shall be submitted for the General Fund, the Highway Fund, including all funds pertaining to the Department of Public Safety and the Department of Transportation, and the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife funds.

27 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited 28 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-29 proved.
