AN ACT to Provide Funds for Support of the
Maine Teacher in Space Program.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

20-A MRSA §17103, sub-§3 is enacted to read:

3. Nationally recognized teacher initiative award. The commissioner may annually award up to \$20,000 to nationally recognized teachers, such as the 2 representatives from the State in the Teacher in Space Program, to cover travel and other expenses while making appearances and disseminating information around the State regarding the national programs in which they participated. No more than \$10,000 may be awarded to any one teacher in a given year.
