Whereas, Acts of the Legis-13 lature do not become effective until 90 days after 14 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 15 Whereas, the Portland fish pier is about to enter 16 commercial operation; and 17 Whereas, its success is dependent upon a high volume of fish landed or traded in Portland; and 18 19 Whereas, the high license fees for nonresident 20 commercial fishermen imposes a burden on Maine fishermen who land fish in states with reciprocal licens-21 22 ing fee arrangements; and 23 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 24 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 25 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 26 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-27 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 28 therefore, ' 29 Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end 30 before the Statement of Fact the following: 31 'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited 32 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-33 proved.
