22 23 24 25 26 27 28	This amendment allows the lien created to enforce the payment of amounts due under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 26, section 629-B, subsection 7, to be created and enforced in the same manner as mechanics' liens under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 10. If perfected under Title 10, the lien is effective on the date of the employer's violation.
