15 16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27	Each member of the Senate and House of Representatives shall be reimbursed for actual regular airfare expenses from his place of abode to Augusta for one trip each week when the Legislature is in regular session and, when the Legislature is not in regular session, for days when meetings or daily sessions are held, provided that: The distance from his place of abode to Augusta is more than 150 miles, the mileage is determined by the most reasonable direct route; the Legislator submits a receipt of actual expenses to the Executive Director of the Legislative Council; and, where commercial flights are available, the total flight cost does not exceed the cost of a
