HOUSE AMENDMENT "<sup>B</sup>" to H.P. 1567, L.D. 2217,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Implement Certain Recommendations of  
the State Compensation Commission."

Amend the bill by inserting after section 7 the  
following:

'Sec. 8. 3 MRSa §2-B is enacted to read:

§2-B. Records of expenditures

The Clerk of the House of Representatives shall keep a record of money expended for any legislative mailing by each member of the House of Representatives and shall make those records available for public inspection. The Secretary of the Senate shall keep a record of money expended for any legislative mailing by each Senator and shall make those records available for public inspection.

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires that full disclosure of money expended for mailings be made by members of the House of Representatives and members of the Senate. Records of those expenditures shall be made available for public inspection.
