18 AN ACT to Provide Funds for Graduate Study
19 for the Protection, Preservation and
20 Perpetuation of the Bee Industry in

23 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
24 follows:

25 Appropriation. The following funds are appropri-
26 ated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes
27 of this Act.

30 All Other \$10,000

3 The program will
4 include one stu-
5 dent and the
6 funds will be

14 portion of the
15 fund which is
16 matched on a
17 50/50 basis by
18 funds from pri-
19 vate sources may
20 be expended and
21 any nonmatched

25 STATEMENT OF FACT

26 The purpose of this bill is to provide \$10,000 in
27 state funds for a graduate study program to help the
28 bee industry at a time of critical need. The program
29 will involve one student for one year. The bill re-
30 quires that the appropriation must be matched on a
31 50/50 basis by private funds.
