1	STATEMENT OF FACT
2	The amendment makes the following changes.
3 4 5 6 7 8	Section 5 is amended to remove an unnecessary sentence, to make a grammatical correction and to reletter the paragraphs. It also adds a new provision requiring the advisory committee to make an annual report to the legislative committee dealing with education.
9 10 11	Section 7 is amended to make the percent of state subsidy equal to a unit's percent of state aid instead of a straight 50%.
12	Section 9 is amended by adjusting the allocation.
13 14 15 16 17	Section 10 transfers accumulated interest earned on the Permanent School Fund from the special revenue fund back into the Permanent School Fund. The Permanent School Fund has a higher rate of earnings than the special revenue fund. The difference in earnings is about \$20,000 on \$500,000.
19	Finally, the bill adds a fiscal note.
