COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1569, L.D. 2219, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Technical Assistance to Schools on Truancy, Dropouts and Alternative Educational Programs and to Amend the Permanent School Fund."

Amend the bill in section 4 in paragraph L in the 4th line (page 2, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined punctuation " , "

Further amend the bill in section 5 in that part designated "§5151." in the first paragraph, by striking out all of the last underlined sentence.

Further amend the bill in section 5, in that part designated "§5152." in subsection 3, in the last 2 lines (page 4, lines 37 and 38 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "a representative from each of the following groups:" and inserting in its place the following: "representation from each of the following:"

Further amend the bill in section 5, in that part designated "§5152." in subsection 3, by striking out all of paragraphs H, I and J and inserting in their place the following:

'H. Department of Human Services;

I. Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation;

J. Department of Corrections;

K. Department of Labor;

L. A local positive action committee on truancy,

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1569, L.D. 2219

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The amendment makes the following changes.

3 Section 5 is amended to remove an unnecessary  
4 sentence, to make a grammatical correction and to  
5 reletter the paragraphs. It also adds a new provision  
6 requiring the advisory committee to make an annual  
7 report to the legislative committee dealing with edu-  
8 cation.

9 Section 7 is amended to make the percent of state  
10 subsidy equal to a unit's percent of state aid in-  
11 stead of a straight 50%.

12 Section 9 is amended by adjusting the allocation.

13 Section 10 transfers accumulated interest earned  
14 on the Permanent School Fund from the special revenue  
15 fund back into the Permanent School Fund. The Perma-  
16 nent School Fund has a higher rate of earnings than  
17 the special revenue fund. The difference in earnings  
18 is about \$20,000 on \$500,000.

19 Finally, the bill adds a fiscal note.
