Further amend the resolution in the by striking 22 out all of the question and inserting in its place 23 24 the following: 25 'Shall the Constitution of Maine be amended to permit legislative disapproval of agency rules?' 26 STATEMENT OF FACT 27 This resolution permits the Legislature to over-28 29 see implementation of its rule-making authority by reviewing, and if necessary, disapproving administra-30 31 tive rules. 32 The procedure for implementing this resolution by the Legislature would be enacted into law. It is the 33 34 intent that this procedure include suspension of a
