17 18	Whereas, there are pending before the Legislature several other proposed changes to these laws; and
19 20 21 22	Whereas, it is necessary to enact this legislation as an emergency to enable those proposed changes to be made to the recodified version of the retirement laws to avoid conflict and ambiguities; and
23 24 25 26 27 28	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
29 30	Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:
31 32 33	'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
