HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 886, L.D. 2231, Bill, "AN ACT to Recodify the Laws of the Maine State Retirement System."

10 Amend the bill in section 5 in that part desig-11 nated "<u>§17001.</u>" in subsection 42 in the first line 12 (page 11, line 24 in L.D.) by inserting after the 13 word and punctuation "<u>teacher</u>," the following: 14 'preschool teacher,'

Further amend the bill in section 5 in that part designated "<u>§17713</u>." in subsection 2, paragraph A, subparagraph (3), in the 2nd line (page 50, line 19 in L.D.) by striking out the figure "<u>5</u>" and inserting in its place the following: '<u>2</u>'

20 Further amend the bill in section 5 in that part 21 designated "<u>§17751.</u>" by inserting after subsection 3 22 the following:

23 '4. Special provision for certain legislative
24 employees. A legislative employee shall recieve a
25 full year of service credit for the period of January
26 1, 1978, to January 1, 1984, for each year of the
27 legislative biennium in a position that may be full28 time under Title 3, sections 22 and 42.'

29 Further amend the bill in section 5 by inserting 30 before "<u>ARTICLE 4</u>" (page 84 in L.D.) the following:

31 '§17910. Voluntary return to service

32 <u>1. Right to reinstatement. If the beneficiary</u> 33 of a disability retirement benefit decides that he is 34 no longer incapacitated and is able to perform the 35 duties of his employment position, the employer for HOUSE AMENDMENT " \mathcal{B} " to s.p. 886, l.d. 2231

1 whom he last worked prior to becoming disabled shall reinstate the person to the first available position for which the beneficiary is gualified and is consistent with the beneficiary's prior work experience. If a collective bargaining agreement applies to such a position, the employer may offer only a position which the beneficiary could claim by virtue of the seniority accumulated at the time of the disability.

9 Dispute over mental or physical capacity. 2. 10 the event there is a dispute between the beneficiary and the former employer over the beneficiary's mental 11 or physical capacity to perform a specific job, at the option of the beneficiary that dispute shall be resolved by the majority decision of 3 physicians, one appointed and reimbursed by the beneficiary, one 12 13 14 15 appointed and reimbursed by the employer and one ap-pointed by the executive director and reimbursed by 16 17 18 the Maine State Retirement System.

19 <u>3.</u> Termination or reduction in benefits. At the 20 option of the former beneficiary who has returned to 21 an employment position, the disability retirement 22 benefit may be terminated as of the end of the first 23 month he is reinstated to a position or may be sub-24 ject to section 17906, subsection 3.

4. Reinstatement of benefits. If, during the first 5 years of reinstatement, the former beneficia-25 26 ry again becomes disabled as a result of the medical condition for which the initial disability retirement 27 28 allowance was granted and terminates employment, the Maine State Retirement System shall resume paying the 29 30 31 disability retirement benefit payable prior to the 32 reinstatement with all applicable cost-of-living ad-33 justments. The Maine State Retirement System may re-34 quire examinations or tests to determine whether a 35 member's medical condition is the same as that for 36 which disability retirement was initially granted.

Corrects a problem concerning years of creditable service for 2 legislative employees; 6 7 4. Restores language in compliance with an At-8 torney Generals Opinion; 9 5. Adds a comma to clarify the groupings of a 10 series of groups; 11 6. Removes language that would have required an 12 appropriation be added to the original bill; 13 7. Adds an appropriation to fund changes made by 14 this amendment; and 15 8. Adds an effective date of January 1, 1987 to 16 new draft. 17 7414041086
