18 Resolve, for Laying of the County Taxes and
19 Authorizing Expenditures of York
20 County for the Year 1986.

22 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves
23 of the Legislature do not become effective until 90
24 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies;
25 and

26 Whereas, York County has certain expenses and li-
27 abilities which must be met as they become due; and

28 Whereas, it is necessary that the taxes for the
29 year 1986 hereinafter mentioned be immediately as-
30 sessed in order to provide the required revenue for
31 the county; and

32 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
33 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
34 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
35 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-

1 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
2 therefore, be it

3 Sec. 1. York County; taxes apportioned. Re-
4 solved: That the following sum is granted as a tax
5 on York County to be apportioned, assessed, collected
6 and applied to the purposes of paying debts and nec-
7 essary expenses of the county as authorized herein,
8 and for other purposes of law, for the calendar year
9 1986:

12 ; and be it further

13 Sec. 2. General Fund expenditures authorized.
14 Resolved: That the following sums, based on the
15 county budget filed in the office of the Secretary
16 of State, are authorized as General Fund expenditures
17 by the county during the calendar year 1986, in the
18 specific total amounts of expenditures for personal
19 services, contractual services, commodities and capi-
20 tal expenditures for each account in the county bud-
