1 and on behalf of the State to an amount not exceeding \$1,000,000, for the purpose of raising funds to pro-2 3 vide for construction of an activity building at the 4 Augusta Mental Health Institute as authorized by sec-5 6. The bonds shall be deemed a pledge of the tion 6 full faith and credit of the State. The bonds shall not run for a longer period than 5 years from the 7 8 date of the original issue of the bonds. Any issuance 9 of bonds may contain a call feature at the discretion 10 of the Treasurer of State with the approval of the 11 Governor.

12 Sec. 2. Records of bonds issued to be kept by 13 the State Auditor and Treasurer of State. The State Auditor shall keep an account of the bonds, showing 14 15 the number and amount of each, the date when payable and the date of delivery of the bonds to the Treasur-er of State who shall keep an account of each bond 16 17 18 showing the number of the bond, the name of the successful bidder to whom sold, the amount received for 19 the bond, the date of sale and the date when payable. 20

21 Sec. 3. Sale, how negotiated; proceeds appropri-22 ated. The Treasurer of State may negotiate the sale of the bonds by direction of the Governor, but no such bond may be loaned, pledged or hypothecated in 23 24 25 behalf of the State. The proceeds of the sale of the bonds, which shall be held by the Treasurer of State and paid by him upon warrants drawn by the State Con-26 27 28 troller, are appropriated to be used solely for the purposes set forth in this Act. Any unencumbered bal-29 30 ances remaining at the completion of the project in 31 section 6 shall lapse to the debt service account es-32 tablished for the retirement of these bonds.

33 Sec. 4. Interest and debt retirement. Interest 34 due or accruing upon any bonds issued under this Act 35 and all sums coming due for payment of bonds at matu-36 rity shall be paid by the Treasurer of State.

37 Sec. 5. Disbursement of bonds proceeds. The pro-38 ceeds of the bonds set out in section 6 shall be ex-39 pended under the direction and supervision of the Di-40 rector of Public Improvements. Sec. 6. Allocations from General Fund bond issue

7 Sec. 7. Contingent upon ratification of bond is8 sue. Sections 1 to 6 shall not become effective un9 less and until the people of the State have ratified
10 the issuance of bonds as set forth in this Act.

11 Sec. 8. Appropriation balances at year end. At 12 the end of each fiscal year, all unencumbered appro-13 priation balances representing state money shall car-14 ry forward from year to year. Bond proceeds which have not been expended within 10 years after the date 15 16 of the sale of the bonds shall lapse to General Fund 17 debt service.

18 Sec. 9. Bonds authorized, but not issued. Any bonds authorized, but not issued, or for which bond anticipation notes have not been issued within 5 19 20 21 years of the ratification of this Act, shall be deauthorized and may not be issued, provided that the 22 23 Legislature may, within 2 years after the expiration of that 5-year period, extend the period for issuing any remaining unissued bonds or bond anticipation 24 25 notes for an additional amount of time not to exceed 26 27 5 years.

28 Sec. 10. Statutory referendum procedure; submission at statewide election; form of question; effec-tive date. This Act shall be submitted to the legal 29 30 31 voters of the State of Maine at the next general 32 election in the month of November following passage 33 of this Act. The city aldermen, town selectmen and 34 plantation assessors of this State shall notify the inhabitants of their respective cities, towns and plantations to meet, in the manner prescribed by law 35 and 36 37 for holding a statewide election, to vote on the ac-38 ceptance or rejection of this Act by voting on the 39 following question:

40 "Do you favor a \$1,000,000 bond issue to provide 41 for construction of an activity building at the Au-42 gusta Mental Health Institute?"

The legal voters of each city, town and planta-1 2 tion shall vote by ballot on this question and shall 3 designate their choice by a cross or check mark 4 placed within a corresponding square below the word "Yes" or "No." The ballots shall be received, sorted, 5 counted and declared in open ward, town and planta-6 7 tion meetings and returns made to the Secretary of 8 State in the same manner as votes for members of the Legislature. The Governor shall review the returns 9 and, if it appears that a majority of the legal vot-10 11 ers are in favor of the Act, the Governor shall pro-12 claim that fact without delay, and the Act shall be-13 come effective 30 days after the date of the procla-14 mation.

15 The Secretary of State shall prepare and furnish 16 to each city, town and plantation all ballots, re-17 turns and copies of this Act necessary to carry out 18 the purpose of this referendum.

19 STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides for a bond issue in the amount of \$1,000,000 for construction of an activity building at the Augusta Mental Health Institute.

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
