SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1610, L.D. 2267,
Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Medicaid Coverage for Mental
Health Services for Children in Certain Hospital Fa-
cilities."

Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting
clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
lature do not become effective until 90 days after
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, it is necessary that funds be
deappropriated in fiscal year 1985-86; and

Whereas, unless this legislation is enacted as
emergency legislation it will not take effect until
after the close of fiscal year 1985-86; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
the Constitution of Maine and required the following
legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
therefore, '

Further amend the bill by striking out all of
section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are
appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the
purposes of this Act.

15 STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This new draft makes the original bill consistent
17 with federal requirements and corrects the language
18 of the original bill. It also adds an appropriation,
19 a deappropriation, emergency preamble, emergency
20 clause and an allocation.
