AN ACT to Provide Medicaid Coverage for Mental Health Services for Children in Certain Hospital Facilities.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3174-C is enacted to read:
§3174-C. Coverage for inpatient hospital mental disease treatment services
Provided that the federal maintenance-of-effort requirements are satisfied, the department shall provide reimbursement, under the United States Social Security Act, Title XIX, for inpatient psychiatric facility care and treatment of patients with mental diseases.
Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT
This new draft makes the original bill consistent with federal requirements and corrects the language of the original bill. It also adds an appropriation and an allocation.
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
