18 AN ACT to Provide Medicaid Coverage for
19 Mental Health Services for Children in
20 Certain Hospital Facilities.

22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
23 follows:

24 Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3174-C is enacted to read:

25 §3174-C. Coverage for inpatient hospital mental dis-
26 ease treatment services

27 Provided that the federal maintenance-of-effort
28 requirements are satisfied, the department shall pro-
29 vide reimbursement, under the United States Social
30 Security Act, Title XIX, for inpatient psychiatric
31 facility care and treatment of patients with mental
32 diseases.

33 Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are
34 appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the
35 purposes of this Act.
