21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 Sec. 1. Legislative intent. It is the intent of
24 the Legislature that the Department of Human Services
25 increase the pharmacist dispensing fee from \$3.20 to
26 \$3.45.

27 Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are
28 appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the
29 purposes of this Act.

9 FISCAL NOTE

10 This new draft will require a General Fund appro-
11 priation of \$104,964 and a federal fund allocation of
12 \$232,106 to the Department of Human Services for med-
13 ical care payments to providers and intermediate care
14 facility providers.

15 STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This new draft increases the dispensing fee to
17 pharmacists from \$3.20 to \$3.45, an increase of 25¢.
