SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to  
H.P. 1614, L.D. 2269, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to  
Boards and Commissions."

Amend the Amendment by striking out everything  
after the title and inserting in its place the fol-  
lowing:

'Amend the Bill in section 6 by striking out all  
of paragraphs A to C and inserting in their place the  
following:

'A. If the board fails to respond as provided in  
this subsection, the Commissioner of Finance and  
Administration shall immediately notify the joint  
standing committee of the Legislature having ju-  
risdiction over the operations of State Govern-  
ment of the board's failure to comply with the  
provisions of this chapter.

B. If the board fails to report within 6 months  
from the reporting date specified in section  
12005, the board shall be deemed unwilling to  
fulfill a public purpose and shall be abolished.  
The Commissioner of Finance and Administration  
shall notify the board in writing that its au-  
thority is repealed and the board is abolished.  
The commissioner shall notify the joint standing  
committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction  
over State Government that the board is abol-  
ished.'

Further amend the Bill in section 7 in the 3rd  
line (page 5, line 13 in L.D.) by striking out the  
figure "6" and inserting in its place the figure '7'

1 Further amend the Bill in section 7 in the first  
2 paragraph by inserting before the last sentence the  
3 following: 'The 7th member shall be the Treasurer of  
4 State.'

5 Further amend the Bill in section 7 in subsection  
6 2 in paragraph C in the last line (page 6, line 9 in  
7 L.D.) by striking out the word "and"

8 Further amend the Bill in section 7 in subsection  
9 2 in paragraph D in the last line (page 6, line 13 in  
10 L.D.) by striking out the figure and punctuation  
11 "379." and inserting in its place the following:  
12 '379; and'

13 Further amend the Bill in section 7 in subsection  
14 2 by adding at the end the following:

15 'E. Review and determine the means by which  
16 greater compliance with the reporting provisions  
17 of sections 12005 and 12006 can be achieved.'

18 Further amend the Bill in section 7 in subsection  
19 5 in the 3rd line (page 6, line 22 in L.D.) by strik-  
20 ing out the word "committee" and inserting in its  
21 place the words 'joint standing committee of the Leg-  
22 islature' and in the 4th line (page 6, line 23 in  
23 L.D.) by striking out the word and punctuation "Gov-  
24 ernment," and inserting in their place the following:  
25 'Government at the''

26 STATEMENT OF FACT

27 This amendment removes a penalty provision of the  
28 bill making all decisions by the board null and void  
29 if the board fails to file its financial report with-  
30 in 30 days after being notified of its delinquency,  
31 but retains the provision that the board will be  
32 abolished if it fails to file the report within 6  
33 months.

SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1614, L.D. 2269

1           The amendment requires the Commissioner of Fi-  
2 nance and Administration to notify the joint standing  
3 committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over  
4 State Government of the board's failure to file the  
5 financial report.

6           This amendment also requires the Board of Commis-  
7 sions to review and determine the means by which  
8 boards can be brought into compliance with the re-  
9 porting requirements of current law.

10          atThis amendment adds the Treasurer of State to the  
11 Board of Commissions.


