SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1618, L.D. 2274,
8 Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Workers' Compensation Act
9 to Require Prepayment for Medical Aids and to Make
10 Corrections Relating to Foreign Employees."

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Amend the bill by striking out all of section 5.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment removes the provision of the bill
which allowed a foreign resident's workers' compensa-
tion benefits to be cut off, in certain circum-
stances, before a hearing and final decision on a pe-
tition for review under the Maine Revised Statutes,
Title 39, section 100. Under this amendment, these
employees will be subject to the general rule that
benefits may not be cut off before a hearing and fi-
nal decision on the merits of the petition.


