HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 908, L.D. 2275,
8 Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Use of Sulfite as a Food
9 Preservative."

Amend the Bill in section 3 in subsection 12 by
11 striking out all of the 2nd paragraph (page 3, lines
12 6 to 9 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the fol-
13 lowing:

'If a person sells, offers for sale or serves in any
15 retail store, hotel, restaurant or other public eat-
16 ing place any food or food product, whether or not in
17 package form, to which that person has added any
18 sulfite then:

STATEMENT OF FACT

20

This amendment stipulates that the requirement to
21 display a sign or label indicating that the food or
22 food product contains sulfite only applies if the re-
23 tailer adds any sulfite to the food he serves or
24 sells.
