18 AN ACT to Make Additional Allocations from
19 the Alcohol Premium Fund.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 Sec. 1. Legislative intent. It is the intent of
24 the Legislature that the first priority of the indi-
25 vidual departments of the Alcohol and Drug Abuse
26 Planning Committee is to maintain the funding levels
27 of current quality and needed alcoholism services and
28 programs. A portion of the funds allocated in sec-
29 tion 2 may be utilized, as necessary, to replace re-
30 ductions in Federal Block Alcoholism Services Grants
31 and current Alcohol Premium Fund, prior to the fund-
32 ing of expanded or new programs.

33 Sec. 2. Allocations of Alcoholism Prevention,
34 Education, Treatment and Research Fund. Income to
35 the Alcoholism Prevention, Education, Treatment and
36 Research Fund for the period of July 1, 1986, to June

1	30, 1987, shall be segregated, apportioned and dis-

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STATEMENT OF FACT

The new draft which allocates money from the Alcohol Premium Fund was held over from the First Regular Session of the 112th Legislature. The allocations have been adjusted to reflect its enactment this session instead of last year. In addition, this new draft adds language to ensure that if federal legislation reduces funding for current programs, this money will be applied to existing programs prior to funding of expanded programs.

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
