1	STATEMENT OF FACT
2 3 4 5	The purpose of this amendment is to eliminate from the new draft the section giving the State Liquor Commission the authority to waive the 10-mile spacing restriction on the location of agency stores.
6 7	The title of the new draft is amended to $\ensuremath{\text{reflect}}$ this change.
8 9 10	The amendment leaves intact the authorization of one additional state discount liquor store to be located near Exit 1 of the Maine Turnpike.
