HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A"  
to S.P. 914, L.D. 2282, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to  
Commercial Vehicles."

Amend the amendment by inserting after the 4th  
paragraph after the title the following:

'Amend the bill in Part A by adding after section  
4 the following:

'Sec. 4-A. 29 MRSA §1655, 6th ¶, as amended by  
PL 1985, c. 26, §3, and c. 429, §18, is repealed and  
the following enacted in its place:

Commodity permits may be obtained upon payment of  
the required fee, from any branch office of the Motor  
Vehicle Division or from any agent of the Secretary  
of State who has been appointed for that specific  
purpose. Any agent appointed by the Secretary of  
State may charge any applicant for a commodity permit  
\$1 over and above the required permit fee and may re-  
tain the dollar as the agent's compensation for per-  
forming this function. A permit may be issued for a  
period of 12 months or less, provided that no permit  
may extend beyond the expiration of the annual regis-  
tration or short-term registration permit. An annual  
commodity permit purchased in conjunction with an an-  
nual registration shall expire with the registration.  
The appointment of agents shall be limited to either  
municipal tax collectors or town or city managers.  
The fee shall be based upon the vehicle type and pe-  
riod of validity.

12 Further amend the amendment by striking out all  
13 of the 5th paragraph after the title and inserting in  
14 its place the following:

15 'Further amend the bill in Part A by striking out  
16 all of sections 5 and 6 and inserting in their place  
17 the following:

18 'Sec. 5. Effective date. The provisions of sec-  
19 tion 4 shall take effect on January 1, 1987, and are  
20 repealed on December 31, 1988. The provisions of sec-  
21 tion 4-A shall take effect on January 1, 1989.'

22 Further amend the amendment by by inserting after  
23 the 7th paragraph after the title the following:

24 'Further amend the bill in Part B in section 2,  
25 in that part designated "§1654." by striking out all  
26 of the next to the last paragraph.

27 Further amend the bill in Part B in section 4 in  
28 that part designated "§1701." in the 2nd paragraph in  
29 the 3rd line from the end (page 13, line 22 in L.D.)  
30 by inserting after the underlined word "structure"  
31 the following: 'to its condition prior to the  
32 accident'

33 Further amend the amendment by striking out all  
34 of the 8th paragraph after the title and inserting in

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1 its place the following:

2 'Further amend the bill in Part B in section 6,  
3 in that part designated "§1803." in the 2nd line  
4 (page 14, line 13 in L.D.) by striking out the word  
5 "Notwithstanding" and inserting in its place the fol-  
6 lowing: 'Subject to the provisions of Title 5, chap-  
7 ter 375, subchapter 4, notwithstanding,' and in the  
8 4th line (page 14, line 15 in L.D.) by striking out  
9 the following: "sections 242 to 246-A" and inserting  
10 in its place the following: 'section 1656'

11 Further amend the amendment by inserting before  
12 the last paragraph before the statement of fact the  
13 following:

14 'Further amend the bill in Part C in section 8 in  
15 subsection 1-A in the 4th paragraph from the end in  
16 the 4th line (page 23, line 25 in L.D.) by inserting  
17 after the underlined word "privileges" the following:  
18 ', as identified by the commissioner according to his  
19 rule-making authority'

20 Further amend the bill in Part C, in section 8,  
21 in subsection 1-A, by striking out all of the 2nd and  
22 3rd paragraphs from the end (page 23, lines 27 to 43  
23 and page 24 lines 1 to 3 in L.D.)'
