19 20	State may charge any applicant for a commodity permit \$1 over and above the required permit fee and may re-
21	tain the dollar as the agent's compensation for per-
22	forming this function. A permit may be issued for a
23	period of 12 months or less, provided that no permit
24	may extend beyond the expiration of the annual regis-
25	tration or short-term registration permit. An annual
26	commodity permit purchased in conjunction with an an-
27	nual registration shall expire with the registration.
