the underlined word and punctuation "purposes." and  
inserting in their place the following: 'purposes;  
and'

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Further amend the Bill in section 5 in that part  
designated "§6256." in subsection 4 by adding at the  
end the following:

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'D. Atlantic salmon raised by means of  
aquaculture.'
