18 AN ACT Relating to the Labeling of Milk.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §2902, first ¶ is amended to
23 read:

24 No milk dealer shall sell milk or cream without
25 first obtaining a license from the commissioner. No
26 person shall produce grade A milk for sale without
27 first obtaining a license from the commissioner to
28 produce grade A milk, and no person shall pasteurize
29 grade A milk for sale without first obtaining a li-
30 cense from the commissioner to pasteurize grade A
31 milk.

32 Sec. 2. 7 MRSA §2902, 10th ¶ is repealed.

33 Sec. 3. 7 MRSA §2902, last ¶, as amended by PL
34 1977, c. 694, §138, is repealed.
