15 16	tion, appointed by the president of that association; one member of the Maine State Bar Association, ap-
17	pointed by the president of that association;" and
18 19	inserting in its place the following: 'one member of the Maine Trial Lawyers Association and one member of
20 21	the Maine State Bar Association, each to be jointly
22	appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representa- tives and President of the Senate from lists of mem-
23 24	bers selected and proposed by the president of the respective organizations;'
25	STATEMENT OF FACT
26 27	This amendment changes the power to appoint mem- bers from the respective presidents of the Maine Tri-

bers from the respective presidents of the Maine Trial Lawyers Association and Maine State Bar Association to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
