7 HOUSE AMENDMENT "*B*" to H.P. 1624, L.D. 2289,
8 "Resolve, to Establish a Commission to Examine Prob-
9 lems of Tort Litigation and Liability Insurance in
10 Maine."

11 Amend the resolve, in the 6th paragraph after the
12 title in the 15th, 16th, 17th and 18th lines (page 2,
13 lines 25 to 29 in L.D.) by striking out the follow-
14 ing: "one member of the Maine Trial Lawyers Associa-
15 tion, appointed by the president of that association;
16 one member of the Maine State Bar Association, ap-
17 pointed by the president of that association;" and
18 inserting in its place the following: 'one member of
19 the Maine Trial Lawyers Association and one member of
20 the Maine State Bar Association, each to be jointly
21 appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representa-
22 tives and President of the Senate from lists of mem-
23 bers selected and proposed by the president of the
24 respective organizations;'

STATEMENT OF FACT

26 This amendment changes the power to appoint mem-
27 bers from the respective presidents of the Maine Tri-
28 al Lawyers Association and Maine State Bar Associa-
29 tion to the President of the Senate and the Speaker
30 of the House of Representatives.
