HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1625, L.D. 2290,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize Preferred Provider Ar-  
rangements in Maine and to Establish a Cash Reserve  
Requirement for Health Maintenance Organizations."

Amend the Bill in section 2 in that part desig-  
nated "§2338." in the 5th line (page 5, line 15 in  
L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "providers  
and"

Further amend the Bill in section 2 in that part  
designated "§2339." by striking out all of the last  
sentence and inserting in its place the following:  
'The payment shall be at least 80% of the amount that  
would have been paid by the nonprofit service organi-  
zation for services rendered by a preferred  
provider.'

Further amend the Bill in section 4 in that part  
designated "§2677." by striking out all of the last  
sentence and inserting in its place the following:  
'The payment shall be at least 80% of the amount that  
would have been paid by the administrator or insurer  
for services rendered by a preferred provider.'
