Amend the bill in section 1 in that part design-
ated "§1783." in the first paragraph in the last
line (page 2, line 35 in L.D.) by striking out the
following: "section." and inserting in its place the
following: "section, Title 12, Title 23 and Title 30,
chapter 233."

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment allows the Department of Transpor-
tation, the Department of Conservation, the Depart-
ment of Marine Resources, the Department of Inland
Fisheries and Wildlife and the Baxter State Park Au-
thority to lease space in buildings under their ju-
risdiction. These agencies have some unique facili-
ties and situations which prevent the efficient ap-
plication of the bill to those agencies. Railroad
facilities, cargo port facilities, public lands fa-
cilities and other types of buildings and facilities
may not be leased in an efficient or easy manner un-
der the bill. In addition, federal rules and laws
governing the use of federal funds that are allocated
to these agencies contain provisions that conflict
with the bill.
