Railroad 24 25 facilities, cargo port facilities, public lands fa-26 cilities and other types of buildings and facilities may not be leased in an efficient or easy manner un-27 28 the bill. In addition, federal rules and laws 29 governing the use of federal funds that are allocated 30 to these agencies contain provisions that 31 with the bill.
